The Florence Elite Soccer Camp is directed by Joel Person. This past season was Person's first season as the head coach for the FMU Women's soccer program and is the Director of Coaching for the Florence Soccer Association. Prior to being the head coach for the women's team,

Person served as the assistant coach for the FMU men's soccer team. As assistant coach, the men won both the Peach Belt Conference regular-season and tournament titles, and earned an invitation to the NCAA Tournament, where the Patriots advanced to the second round. Prior to joining the FMU staff in 2008, Person served one season as an assistant women's coach at the University of Mobile. He also worked for two years as a state coach with the Alabama Youth Soccer Association Olympic Development Program. He was the director of coaching with the Mobile Soccer Club in 2006-2007 and assisted the University of Mobile men's program from 2002 to 2006. In 2002 Person helped coach Mobile to a NAIA national championship. He owns a United States Soccer Federation National B License and a USSF National Youth License.

### Assistant Director

Kevin Laux is currently the Assistant coach with the University of Mobile Women's Team. He graduated from UM in 2005 with a B.S. in Psychology and a minor in Sports Management. He was a member of the 2002 National Championship team and was the team's NAIA Champion of Character recipient in 2004. He holds a USSF Coaching License and completed his Masters of Sports Science Degree in Sports Coaching from the United States Sports Academy March of 2010. Laux also works with the Region III Olympic Development Program as an administrator.

## Camp Objectives

The Florence Elite Soccer Camp will focus on the technical, tactical, and physical aspects of the game of soccer. Special attention will be placed on the tactical development of each player within a team setting through game like situations. The camp will also emphasize the values and character developed through soccer, which apply not only to the game but to every area of life.

Goal Keepers who attend the camp will have separate and specifically designed goal keeper sessions. The GK's will also be incorporated within the team setting in order to learn about the tactical aspects of the position.
